Visitors with disabilities will be pleased to find that many Minneapolis attractions are wheelchair-accessible. There will be no shortage of things to do and see while you're here.

All of the city's downtown **parks** are accessible. Miles of waterfront, the Minneapolis Sculpture Garden and our regional park system, including Minnehaha Falls are accessible.

Minneapolis is known for its world-renowned **theater** scene. Take in a performance at the esteemed Historic Orpheum, State or Pantages Theatres, legendary Guthrie Theater, Jungle Theater, Ordway Center for the Performing Arts, Theatre de la Jeune Lune, and many more – all accessible for persons with disabilities. Also, our downtown movie theater, Crown Theatres, is very accessible with wheelchair seating listening devices, and some audio description.

Music lovers, take heart – fabulous facilities like the Minnesota Orchestra, the Minnesota Opera and Ted Mann Concert Hall are all accessible.
